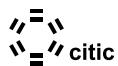

About 3-i ICT

3-i ICT (International, Interdisciplinary and Intersectoral Information and Communications Technology PhD Programme) is an innovative new international PhD programme designed by CITIC (University of A Coruña).

The aim of 3-i ICT is to fund 8 excellent Early-Stage Researchers to carry out their interdisciplinary PhD projects at CITIC on topics related to the centre's main areas of research.

The programme has a strongly intersectoral and international character, with secondments in prestigious institutions in Spain and abroad, and co-supervision by one expert from the field of ICT and a second from a different academic discipline.

CITIC is the first Galician institution to receive funding for its programme from the flagship Horizon 2020 Marie Skłodowska-Curie Action (MSCA) COFUND scheme. 3-i ICT is co-funded by the Galician Department of Culture, Education and Universities.

Objectives

- Offer an excellent PhD programme in terms of research and innovation.
- Train and nurture the next generation of ESRs in scientific and technical excellence and equip them with outstanding skills and transferable expertise to help build a better, stronger, more sustainable future.
- Implement innovative actions based on 3-i priorities aimed at boosting the careers of ESRs.
- Build partnerships and mutual awareness between ESRs and private business actors through innovative individual projects and non-academic co-supervision.
- Establish specific actions for the promotion of women in science.
- Enhance the training programme for ESRs at CITIC.
- Improve the attractiveness of CITIC as a hub for new research talent.

Timeline

The programme will run for five years from 1st January 2022 to 31st December 2026, and will include two calls for candidates:

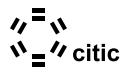
1st call

- **1st April 2022** - Opening first call for candidates
- **31st May 2022** - Deadline first call for candidates
- **June 2022** - Entry and eligibility check
- **June – July 2022** - External evaluation
- **July – August 2022** - Interviews
- **30th September 2022** - Final funding decision
- **October – December 2022** - Signing of contracts

2nd call

- **1st January 2023** - Opening second call for candidate
- **28th February 2023** - Deadline second call for candidates
- **March 2023** - Entry and eligibility check
- **April – May 2023** - External evaluation
- **May – June 2023** - Interviews
- **31st July 2023** - Final funding decision
- **August – October 2023** - Signing of contracts
